

### **How to Change the Weather Location for your Grandstream Device**

This article explains how to change the weather location on your Grandstream GXP Series phone. If the default setting displays the incorrect location for the weather application, please follow these simple steps to manually enter the correct weather location for your area.

First, we need to look up the IP address for your device. This can be done simply by pressing the UP-arrow navigation key. The screen will display the current IP address assigned to that particular phone. Please copy the IP address exactly how it is, then open a web browser and in the address bar, enter the IP address and click Enter. After you hit Enter, you will see the below referenced screen.

***On the login screen, please enter the username and password as seen in the picture below.***

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To change the Weather App location, Select 'Self-Defined City Code'. For the Self-Defined City Code, please enter the City and State of the location you would like to display. Once entered, click Save and Apply. The changes will take effect immediately without a need to reboot your device. You may now close out of the web browser.
